


A 14 inch Ponderosa Pine bears S 43 E, 78.52 feet, marked CS 1/16 S 36 BT. on a single blaze.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the



A 14 inch diameter P.Pine bears S50°E 63.44 feet marked CS1/16 S36 BT


A 18 inch diameter Tamarack bears S69°W 75.59 feet marked CS1/16 S36 BT
