

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found stone...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding earth mound and 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Buried original stone alongside. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. New bearing trees established. A L.P. pine 12" dia brs S77½ W, 65.5' dist marked 1/4S8 BT. A L.P. pine 12" dia brs N20°E, 107.1' dist marked 1/4S9 BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 190 East.
