
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION




No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which:

New BTs:


A 13 inch diameter White Fir bears S50°E, 3.88 feet marked SW1/16 S19 BT A 12 inch diameter White Fir bears S37°W, 17.76 feet marked X BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached 54-3 and 54-9 signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with 54-9 and 54-2 signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 8, 1988.





I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 18° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
