
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract number 683 dated June 7, 1898. Surveyor General record states: Set basalt stone 15x12x7 ins for 4 sec cor from which;

A yellow pine 18 in diam bears $$62^{\circ}15^{\circ}E$$ 110 lks dist A yellow pine 26 in diam bears $$N6^{\circ}W$$ 24 lks dist



No record of subsequent monumentation found in county records Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 15x9x7 inches marked 4 \$19 firmly set in mound of stone

Found a 36 inch diameter P.Pine live and vigorous with blaze evident North 2^{120} West, 15.6 feet to face of blaze (Record N60W 24 1ks)



A 16 inch diameter Red Fir bears \$110E 43.83 feet marked 4 \$30 BT

Buried the original corner stone South and alongside of monument Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with 54-9 sign attached and 54-2 sign attached
