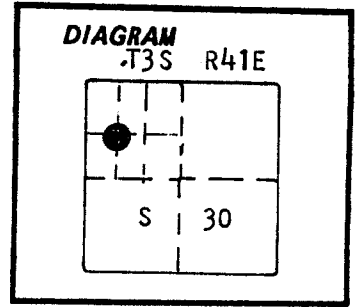


BETWEEN S-1 & S-2

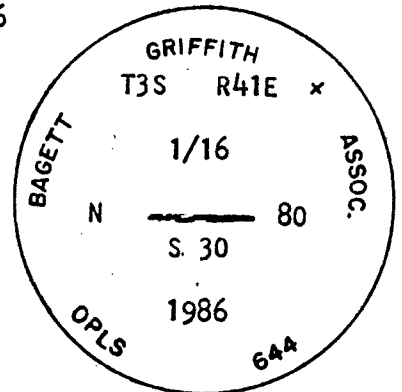

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground: from which:

An 18 inch Spruce bears N 15° E, 7.41 feet, marked X BT.

A 22 inch Douglas Fir bears N 30° W, 42.21 feet, marked N 1/16 S30 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet West with a 54-9 sign attached.
