
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract number 683 dated June 7, 1898. Surveyor General record states:

Set basalt stone 14x10x5 ins for 4 sec cor from which;

A spruce 21 in diam bears N5°E 121 1ks dist A tamarack 16 in diam bears S40°30'W 28 1ks dist



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in the county records. Description of corner evidence found:

Stone 16"x11"x5", marked 4 in large mound of stone

Found a stump hole that bears N  $_{5}^{\circ}$  E, 121 1ks.

A Tamarack remains, bears S 40120 W, 28 1ks, uprooted and burned, nothing visible

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the stone position, I set a 2½1x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 18 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 4 foot base to top of cap, from which:


A 6'x4'x6' high rock outcrop bears East, 20.40 feet, marked X BO

A 12 inch Spruce bears S 1° W, 15.41 feet, marked 4 S29 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with a 54-4 sign attached.
