
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Alonzo Gesner under GLO contract number 683 dated June 7, 1898. Surveyor General record states:

Set a fir post 5 ft long 4 ins sqr for 4 sec cor from which;

A spruce 8 in diam bears N22°30'E 30 1ks dist A black pine 13 in diam bears N18°30'W 19 1ks dist



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records. Description of corner evidence found:

Charred remains of post in small mound of stone.

Remains of 8^{11} spruce bears N 18^{120} w, 19 1ks, dead and down rotting, blazes evident with dim scribing.

See map of survey number 29-86 filed in the office of the Union County Surveyor Description of monument and accessories lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At the post position, I set a 2½ x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown 28 inches in the ground and raised a small mound of stone around cap, from which:

A 7 inch Tamarack bears N 57° E, 35.20 feet, marked 4 \$33 BT.

A 14 inch Tamarack bears S 40° W, 36.18 feet, marked 4 S32 BT.


Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with a 54-9 sign attached.
