


History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½1x3011 aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 24 inches in the ground and raised a small mound of stone to top of cap; from which:

A 14 inch Spruce bears N 39 $^{\rm o}$  E, 51.56 feet, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 32 BT.

A 17 inch White Fir bears N 61 $^{\circ}$  W, 49.85 feet, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 32 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet West with a 54-9 sign attached.
