
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T4N R38 E

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Frank W. Campbell under contract # 468 dated April 12, 1883. Set a basalt stone 12"x10"x6", 8"in ground marked t on West face . from which:

A 10^N fir bears S 80^O E 12 lks A 12^N fir bears N 85^O W 82 lks



In a U.S. Dependent resurvey by Otis O. Gould in August 1939 the stone was found and a 1"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap marked as diagram was set 27" in ground with a mound of stone. Old BT A 32" fir bears S 65° E 12 lks(7.9 ft.) Old BT A 30" fir bears S 87° W 85 lks (56.1 ft.)

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 1 iron pipe with brass cap marked as diagram in a mound of stone.

from which:
A 36" fir bears S 65° E 7.9 ft. some marks vis. on choped out blaze.
A 33" fir bears S 87% W 56.1 ft Blaze Healed not opened.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I drove a steel fence post 3 ft. N.E. of corner and attached a 54.4 sign.

New bearing tree:
A 7" fir bears N 56° W 37.1 feet scribed 1/4 S 34 BT

I nailed an alum. tag to bottom blaze of new tree and painted all blazes red. Painted a red band around all BT's and attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs to them.

I hereby certify the above corner location was perpetuated as herein described in July, 1985
