

Dependent Resurvey of Part of S. Bdy. of T. 4 N., R. 38 E.

Chains

2.85 The closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3; which is a basalt stone, 18x8x7 ins., firmly set, marked with 2 grooves on E., 6 grooves on S., and 4 grooves on W. face.

At point for cor:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone deposited at the base, for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.13°W., 80 lks. dist., marks grown over. (Old B. T.)

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.76°E., 40 lks. dist., marked T 4 N R 38 E S 2 C O B T. (New B. T.)

Desc. 280 ft. over SW. slope.

12.10 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.10°E.; asc. 600 ft. over E. slope.

31.10 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 99 ft. over SW. slope.

39.42 Proportionate measurement.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, with brass cap marked

A pine, 28 ins. diam., bears N.24°E., 200 lks. dist., marked T 4 N R 38 E S 35 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.7°W., 236 lks. dist., marked T 4 N R 38 E S 34 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, spruce, and tamarack.

Undergrowth, alder, willow, huckleberry, vinemaple, and buckbrush.

N.89°21'W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 34.

Desc. 207 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

7.45 Draw, course S., asc. 52 ft. over SE. slope.

12.20 Spur, slopes S.20°E.; desc. 136 ft. over SW. slope.
