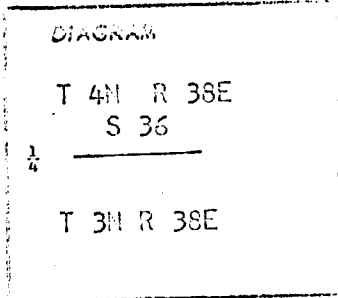


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Z-23

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Kimbrell under Contract No. 700, dated February 9, 1899, page 5 of the Government Field Notes for Township 3 North, Range 38 East.



East on South boundary of Sec. 36.

40.50' set granite stone 20" x 8" x 3" 14" in ground marked 1/4 N face.

Pine 20" in diam. bears South 63 lks.

No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a 20" x 8" x 3" stone about 16" in ground with 1/4 marked on N face. The 1/4 was just visible above ground level. The stone was undisturbed.

I found the remains of a 30" pine stump South 42.00' from stone. The face of stump had rotted away.

I set the monument described below in the location of the stone and placed the stone in the ground beside the monument.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position described above, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 22" in ground with brass cap marked as shown.

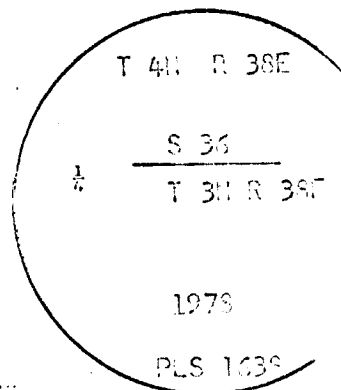
From which I scribed new Bearing Trees:

- A pine 14" in diam. bears S 4° W 25.20' marked S 1/4 BT.
- A fir 12" in diam. bears N 41° E 33.80' marked S 1/4 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked PLS 933 to the BT blazes. I set a steel post 3' W of corner with sings. I painted a 6" red band around BTs and attached BT tags. I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with 19° East variation and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
