

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

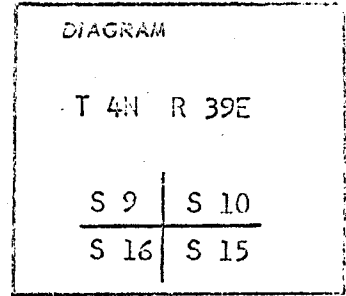
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by John W. Campbell under Contract No. 498, dated March 10, 1884, page 58 of the Government Field Notes for T 4N R 39E.

North between Secs. 15 and 16

60.00' set spruce post 4' long by 4" square 24" in ground marked on NE, SE, SW, NW faces.

No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.



Description of corner evidence found:

I found the 33" tamarack N 68° W 11.54' with no visible scribing, only a scar.
 I found the 36" spruce S 64° E 13.20' with no visible scribing, only a scar.
 I found the 23" tamarack stump S 16° W 23.10'. I opened BT scar on stump. The center is rotted out, but I found "BT" scribed on the back side of the piece I removed. I painted BT scribing and replaced it in stump. I nailed BT and attention signs. No evidence remained of spruce 10" in diam. that bears N 18° E 69 lks.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

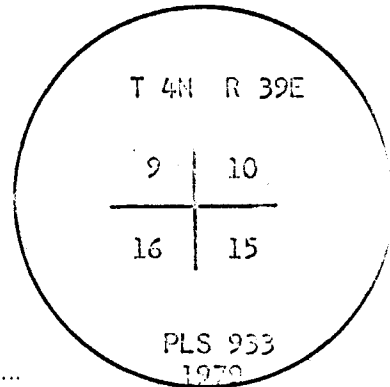
I set a 2½" x 30" iron pipe 24" in ground with a brass cap marked as shown:

From which I scribed:

A fir 9" in diam. bears S 33° W 21.6' scribed T 4N R 39E S 16 BT

I nailed a brass washer marked LS 933 to BT blaze. I painted a red band around tree and scribed areas, placed attention and BT tag on red band, and set a steel post 2' N with attention sign. I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° East variation, measuring distances horizontally to center of BTs. I painted red bands and scars and nailed attention and BT signs and brass washers to the above found BTs.
