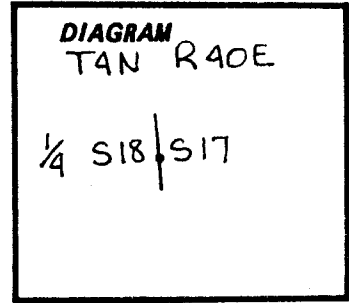
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Frank Campbell under GLO contract no. 507 in 1884.

Set a Fir post 3 feet long 3 ins. square 24 inches in ground mkd 1/4 S on W face.

A Spruce 10" dia. bears N 70°E 56 lks
A Spruce 24" dia. bears S 50°W 33 lks



Description of corner evidence found:

Nothing was found during either preliminary reconnaissance or after corner location was established by proportionment.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the proportioned location we set:

A 2 1/2" Brass Cap on a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 26" in the ground mkd as shown:
From which:

A Tamarack 13" in dia. bears N 62°E a dist. of 16.5 feet
A Fir 11.5" in dia. bears N 75°W a distance of 20.55 ft.

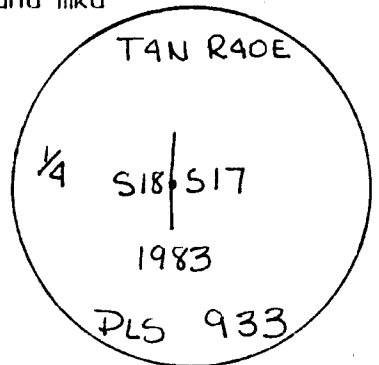
BT's have red painted blazes and a 6" band around them, with signs 54-3 and 54-9 nailed to them. A Brass Washer mkd PLS 933 was nailed to lower scribe

Set a steel fence post 5° North with signs 54-4 and 54-9

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with a 19°30' East variation and measured the horizontal distance to the center of the tree with a steel tape.
