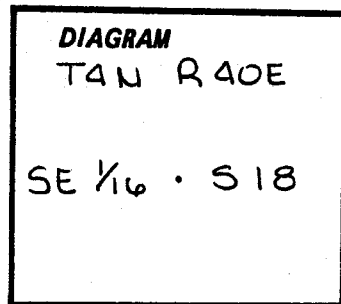


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

M-4

History of original corner establishment:

Unsurveyed - subdivided Section.



Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position described above, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 26 inches in the ground, with a Brass Cap marked as shown:

From which I scribed B.T.'s:

A Fir 26" in diam. bears N 10°30'W a distance of 59.50 feet.
A Fir 21" in diam. bears S 80°30'W a distance of 74.0 feet.

I nailed a brass washer marked PLS 933 to the B.T. blazes.
I set a steel fence post 5' North and West with signs 54-4, 54-9, and 54-2.
I painted a red band around the B.T.'s and face of scribe, nailed 54-3 & 54-9.

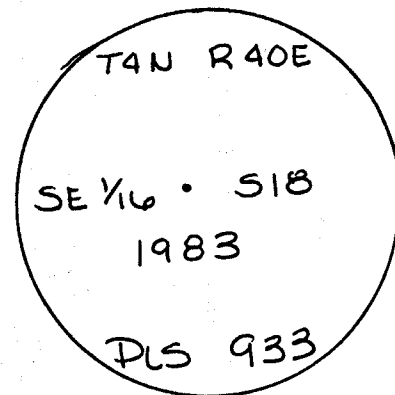
I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 19°30' East variation and measured a horizontal distance to the center of B.T.'s.

This corner was set July 21, 1983
