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

Found a Fir 10" in dia. N  $32^{\circ}$ E 6.2 feet. Found a Fir 18" in dia. N  $60^{\circ}$ W 11.5 feet.



# Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Scribed a BT:

A 16" Fir bears S  $2^{\circ}$ E 30.0 feet mkd  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 21 BT.

Nailed 54-4 and 54-9 sign to BT, and painted face of scribe and a 6" Band around them.

I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with a  $20^{\circ}$ East variation and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BI.

Campbell in 1884 under contract #507. Set a post 3' long, 3" square 24" in ground from which: A Fir 6" dia. bears N60W, 17 lks.-A Fir 12" dia. bears S55E, 25 1ks..

Corner was reestablished by ORLS 506 in 1973. Found: 18" Fir in the NW quadrant, visible scribing.

Set: Reversed the bearing and distance from the found BT and set a 1" gal, iron pipe 36" long with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap.
