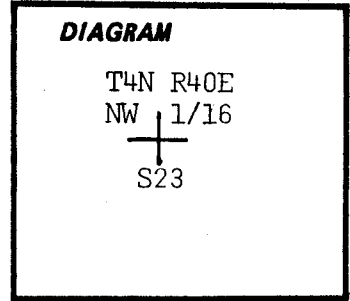

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set corner 24" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 16" Pine bears N57°E., 22.1 ft., scribed NW1/16S23 BT.

A 12" Fir bears N60°W., 69.5 ft., scribed NW1/16S23 BT.

Painted blazes red and 6" red band around.

Placed 54-3s, 54-9s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs.

Placed 54-2 and 54-9 on steel fence post 5' south and 54-2 on steel fence post 5' west of the corner.

Corner falls about 150 ft. south of main road.
