
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Frank Campbell under GLO contract No. 507 in 1884.

Set a Fir Post 3 feet long 3 ins square 24" in ground, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on West face.

A Tamarack 12" diameter bears N 30° E 10 lks. A Fir 6" diameter bears N 66° W 13 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

None

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" galvanized iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Brass Cap rivited to top set 26" in the ground mkd

Scribed two B.T.'s:

A Fir 17" in diameter bears S 30° W 24.0 feet. A Fir $9\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter bears N $85^{\circ}30$ 'E 25.8 feet.

Set a steel post 5.0' North with signs 54-4 & 54-9.

Painted a red band around B.T.'s and face of scribe and nailed on 54-4 & 54-3. Nailed a Brass Washer mkd 933 to lower scribe. I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with a $19^{0}30$ ' East variation and measured a horizontal distance with a steel tape.
