Found no trace of corner stone or BTs.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 24" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 20" Fir bears S72°E., 26.1 ft. scribed 1/4 S24 BT. A 14" Fir bears S88°W., 18.1 ft. scribed 1/4 S23 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around.

Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on steel fence post 5' south of the corner.
