New bearing trees: A spruce 18" dia bears N 08°E., 77.0 ft dist marked T4NR40ES21BT. A spruce 10" dia bears N 16°W., 46.3 ft dist marked T4NR40ES20BT. A spruce 18" dia bears S 71°W., 121.0 ft dist marked T4NR40ES29BT. Brass marked thus: (see diagram) In 1983. PLS 933 found the brass cap and all 3 BT's. He added a bearing object, a 5/8" iron rod with an aluminum cap marked: B.O. x PLS 933. It bears 549°E 5.0 feet. Description of corner evidence found: Found the iron pipe with brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram. From which: A 21" dbh Engleman Spruce bears N7°27'E, 77.3' with scribe. A 16" dbh dead Engleman Spruce bears N16°20'W, 46.4' with scribe. A 29" dbh Engleman Spruce bears \$72°37'W, 120.7' with healed blaze. A 2" diameter aluminum cap on a 5/8" iron rod is stamped B.O. x PLS 933 and bears  $551^{\circ}00^{\circ}E$ ,  $5.13^{\circ}$ . Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: The bearings were based on the surveyed bearing between this corner and the corner 1/2 mile north as recorded by PLS 933 in Union County survey 38-83. I set the following new witness tree: A 9" dbh Engleman Spruce bears N25°08'E, 64.6' scribed T4NR40ES20BT; An aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on the new tree. 
