

A fir 8" dia bears N 20° W., 6.0 ft dist marked 1/4 S 26 BT A larch 7" dia bears S 53° E., 14.5 ft dist marked 1/4 S 25 BT

Each BT has a sign 54-3 attached 6" below a band of red paint and has a brass washer marked RPE 2808 nailed flush with BT blaze.
