Description of corner evidence found:

Found 24" Fir stump. Opened old grown over blaze and found scribed BT. Measured N09°E., 15.7 ft. and found rotten tamarac post going 24" in the ground. No trace of NW BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the above point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 26" in the ground. No rock in the area. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: A 15" Fir bears N55°E., 41.7 ft. scribed 1/4S35 BT. A 14" Fir bears S27°W., 50.8 ft. scribed 1/4 S2 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around.
