
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

Set 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2½" brass cap marked: Pipe is set in ground 24" with a collar of stone. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.



Bearing Trees:

A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears S44°00'E, 66.6' scribed W 1/16 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 13" Ponderosa Pine bears S61°45'W, 74.7' scribed W 1/16 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and HSPS Respine Tree and Land Survey Manument signs are attached USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs are attached.
