
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

Set a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap marked: Pipe is set in ground 6" in a mound of stones. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.

Bearing Trees:

A 15" Ponderosa Pine bears S78°00'E, 129.5' scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$ S1 BT in a single blaze. A 15" Ponderosa Pine bears S2°00'E, 168.4' scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$ S1 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached.

I certify the above corner point was established as hereon described on September 10,1986.
