

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap marked: Pipe is set 18" into the ground with a collar of stone. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.

Bearing Trees:

A 13" Douglas Fir bears S51°45'W, 26.3' scribed CN 1/16 S2 BT in a single blaze. A 14" Douglas Fir bears N34°15'W, 30.3' scribed CN 1/16 S2 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached.
