
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap marked: Pipe is set into ground 14" in a mound of stone. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.



Bearing Trees:

An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears N49°15'W, 128.6' scribed N 1/16 S2 BT in a single blaze. An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears N73°30'E, 82.5' scribed N 1/16 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and USFS Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs attached.
