



A 7" Fir bears: N 56 45'W, 7.8', scribed " \$53BT" on a single blaze.



An 8" Fir bears: N 63°15'E, 14.0'; scribed "½ S2 BT", on a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer marked "RLS 852" is nailed between the letters B and T, on each tree. A 6" red band is painted on each tree and a U.S.F.S. Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument sign is attached.

A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a U.S.F.S. Survey Monument sign attached.
