

Set a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2½" brass cap marked: 745 R348

Pipe is set into ground 4" in a mound of stone. A steel fence c½

post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.

Bearing Trees:

A 7" Ponderosa Pine bears N46°00'W, 44.7' scribed C‡ S2 BT in a single blaze. A 13" Ponderosa Pine bears S11°15'E, 80.3' scribed C‡ S2 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached.
