

Set a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap marked: Pipe is set into the ground 26" with a collar of stone. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.



Bearing Trees:

An 8" Douglas Fir bears N41°15'E, 14.4' scribed C4 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 9" Douglas Fir bears N54°45'W, 6.9' scribed C4 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs are attached.
