
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

## Description of corner evidence found:

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2½" brass cap marked: Pipe is set into ground 8" in a mound of stone. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.



Bearing Trees:

A 22" Ponderosa Pine bears N10°15'W, 192.0' scribed SW 1/16 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 12" Ponderosa Pine bears N89°45'W, 113.4' scribed SW 1/16 S1 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. A 6" red band is painted around each tree and USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached.
