
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1882 by Rufus Moore. Set a basalt stone 20 x 7 x 7 ins 15 ins. in ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside.



Description of corner evidence found: A 20" x 7" x 7" stone with  $\frac{1}{4}$  chiseled on face in a mound of stones.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

Set a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2½" brass cap marked: Pipe is set 8" into ground with a mound of stone built up around it. A steel fence post is set 5' from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.



New witness trees:

A 20" Ponderosa Pine bears S53°45'E, 185.4' scribed ‡ S12 BT in a single blaze. A 14" Ponderosa Pine bears S20°15'W, 173.3' scribed ‡ S11 BT in a single blaze. A 3/4" aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each tree. Each tree is painted with a 6" red band and has USFS Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached.
