
History of original corner establishment: Corner established by Rufus S. Moore under General Land office contract no. 451, dated June 12, 1882. Surveyor General Records states:

Set a post 3 feet long 3 inches square 24 inches in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on North face From which:

A Pine 15 inches in diameter bears \$15°E, 34 1ks distant, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ \$ BT.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

NONE

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At proportionate distance, I set a 2½'x30" Aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28" in the ground, From which:

An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears N44°E, 39.71 feet marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 BT.

An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears S69°W, 20.98 feet, marked \$ 12 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet West with 54-4 sign attached.
