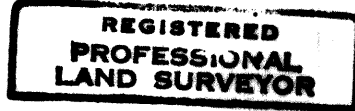
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In the position for the North 1/16 corner, determined as per 1973 BLM Manual instructions and the original locations of the north, south and east quarter corners and the northwest and southwest corners of section 9, I set a 5/8" x 30" rebar with 2" diameter aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above.

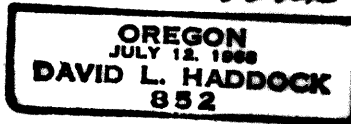
From which, I set the following reference monuments:

A 1/2" x 24" rebar with 2" diameter aluminum cap under an east west fence line, bears N22°15'W, 66.2' marked T4S R35E CW+1/16 S9 PLS 852.
A 1/2" x 24" rebar with 2" diameter aluminum cap driven in a rock outcrop, bears S6°45'W, 37.3' marked T4S R35E CW+1/16 S9 PLS 852.
