

In 1993 David L. Haddock, PLS 852, found the stone. Union County Monumentation record 039-1993R states: Found a 16"x10"x6" stone with chiseled 1/4 at bottom of rockjack at intersection of North and West fence lines. Set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap, buried the stone along side of the pipe, stamped the cap as shown and set the following references, From which:
