




A 9" Douglas Fir bears \$26° W, 19.44 feet, marked CW 1/16 \$13 BT.

A 9" Douglas Fir bears N73°W, 21.71 feet, marked X BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East with a 54-9 and 54-2 sign attached. Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet South with a 54-2 sign attached.
