

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2^{1}2^{1}x30^{11}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 18^{11} in the ground with surrounding mound of stone 5 feet at the base to the top of the cap, from which:

A $5/80\times180$ iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA Survey Marker, bears North, 5.17 feet, set next to steel fence post.

A 5/8"x18" iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA Survey Marker, bears West, 4.32 feet, set next to steel fence post.

Set steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with 54-9 and 54-2 sign attached. Set steel fence post approximately 5 feet yest with 54-2 sign attached.

Corner set 10/18/85 Witness: None



Brass washer nailed to BT blaze.
Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° East declination. Measured to 50d spike set in right side of tree when facing tree, unless otherwise stated.
