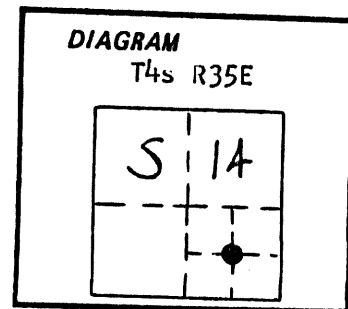

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At position determined by survey I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 13 inches in the ground with surrounding mound of stone 5 feet at the base to the top of the cap, from which:

A 24" Ponderosa Pine bears N37°W, 63.41 feet, marked SE 1/16 S14 BT.

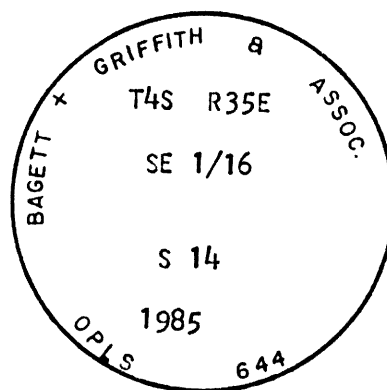
A 22" Ponderosa Pine bears N16°W, 62.70 feet, marked X BT

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East with a 54-4 and 54-2 sign attached.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet South with 54-2 sign attached.
