Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 24" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 18" in the ground to bedrock, at the point determined by the bearing tree stumps. Built a mound of rock & earth to be 30" in diameter by 12" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

15° Ponderosa pine bears S82°E, 43.6 feet scribed 1/4 S20 BT 10° Ponderosa pine bears N13°E, 10.2 feet scribed 1/4 S17 BT

Attached BT and Land Survey Monument signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were turned from the control traverse with a theodolite, basis of bearing being the bearing between the SE and S quarter corners of Section 7 as shown on MOS 43-76, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground. Set a steel fence post 5 feet West of the corner with a Land Survey Monument sign attached.
