

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}x30^{11}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 16" in the ground with surrounding mound of stone 5 foot base to top of cap, from which:


A 14^{11} Ponderosa Pine bears $S6^{\circ}E$, 79.33 feet, marked %1/16 S23 BT.

A 12" Ponderosa Pine bears M3 W, 197.32 feet, marked W 1/16 S14 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with a 54-9 and 54-2 sign attached. Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet South with a

54-2 sign attached.
