
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established by Rufus S. Moore under General Land office contract no. 451, dated June 12, 1882. Surveyor General Records states:

Set a Basalt Stone 18"x12"x10", 12 inches in the ground for corner to sections 13, 14, 23, & 24, marked with 3 notches on the South and 1 notch on the East edges, from which:

A Pine 40 inches in diameter bears \$30°W 191 1ks. distant, marked T4S R35E \$23 BT, and raised a mound of stone alongside. pits impractable.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found Stone 15"x12"x6" with dim marks in mound of stone.

Found SW BT, a 42" Ponderosa Pine \$26°W, 114.95 feet alive and vigerous, blaze evident

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: Ith place of stone I set a 2½ x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 15" in the ground with surrounding mound of stone 5 feet at the base to the top of the cap, from which:

A 24" Ponderosa Pine bears $N60^{\circ}E$, 141.50 feet marked T4S R35E S 13 BT

A 23^{11} Ponderosa Pine bears 558° E, 133.32 feet marked T43 R35E S 24 BT

A 25" Ponderosa Pine bears N5°W, 148.87 feet marked T4S R35E S 14 BF


