
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established by Rufus S. Moore under General Land office contract no. 451, dated June 12, 1882. Surveyor General Records states: Set a basalt stone 24"x18"x12", 18 inches in the ground for 4 section corner marked 4 on North face from which:

A pine 24" in diameter bears N3°E, 38 1ks. dist. marked \(\sigma \) BT.

A Pine 20" in diameter bears \$28°E, 24 1ks. dist. marked \$\square\$ Bt



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County Records. Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At proportionate distance I set a 2½x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground with surrounding mound of stone, from which:


A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears S72°E, 69.14 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 29 BT

A 21" Ponderosa Pine bears N5°E, 52.97 feet, marked 4 \$ 20 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East of corner with 54-4 sign attached.
