
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established by Rufus S. Moore under General Land office contract no. 451, dated June 12, 1882. Surveyor General Records states:

Set a post 3 feet long 3 inches square 24 inches in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on North face, from which:

A pine 36" in diameter bears N190E, 171ks dist. marked \sqrt{3} BT

A Pine 30" in diameter bears S30E, 67 1ks. distant, marked \sqrt{5} BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County Records.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At proportionate distance I set a 2½x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 24 inches in the ground with surrounding mound of dirt, from which:

A 12" diameter Douglas Fir bears N27°E, 22.45 feet, marked 4 S 23 BT


A 27" Ponderosa Pine bears S79°E, 37.02 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East with 54-4 sign

attached.
