A 6 inch diameter P.Pine bears N4°W 35.45 feet marked X BT

Buried the original stone West and alongside of monument Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with 54-4 sign

Corner remonumented April 30, 1986 Witness; Rick Robinson



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of these accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven at the root crown on the right side of the BT. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 by the BT blaze of the new BTs.




