
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set a basalt stone 16x7x6 ins 11 ins in the ground for cor to secs 5 & 6 marked with 5 notches on E and 1 notch on W edges from which;

A pine 15 in diam bears S25°E 32 lks dist marked T4S R36E S5 BT A pine 14 in diam bears S15°W 31 lks dist marked T4S R36E S6 BT I also raise a mound of stone S of cor.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument.

Found a 15 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine stump S25°E, 32 lks, rotted with BT scribes visible.

Found a 27 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine S15°W, 31 lks, alive and vigorous with scribes visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At record bearing and distance from the found original bearing trees, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Tree; A 10 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S78°E, 40.07 feet marked T4S R36E S5 BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 2 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 6 feet East with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 2, 1989.
