
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set a basalt stone 10x9x7 ins 7 ins in the ground for ½ sec cormarked ½ on S face from which;

A pine 28 in diam bears \$16°W 83 lks dist marked \(\frac{1}{4}\)\$ BT I also raise a mound of stone \$5 of cor.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 9x8x6 inches marked with a faint $\frac{1}{4}$ Stone was in center of a mound of stone.

Found a Ponderosa Pine stump S16°W 83 lks, burned with no marks visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: In place of the found original corner stone, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Trees; A 13 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S55°E, 74.95 feet marked ½ S4 BT A 13 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S19°W, 33.49 feet marked ½ S4 BT


Raised a mound of stone around monument, 2 ft. base to top of cap. Buried the original corner stone North and alongside monument.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 21, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° magnetic declination. The distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
