

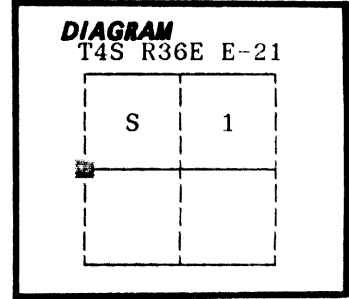
**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1873. Surveyor General record states:

Set a basalt stone 14x8x5 ins 9 ins in the ground for ¼ sec cor marked ¼ on W face, from which:

- A Pine 10 ins diam bears N5°E 56 lks dist marked ¼ S BT
- A Pine 6 ins diam bears S65°W 90 lks dist marked ¼ S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found a stone 15x8x5 inches marked ¼ on W face, sitting erect in a mound of stone.

Found a 20 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine S65°W, 58.90 feet (to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown) live and vigorous with blaze evident. (I did not open.)

Found no evidence of the Northeast bearing tree.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the**

**original location of this corner:** In place of the found original corner stone, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground, from which:

- New BT:
- A 8 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N40°E, 29.08 feet marked ¼ S1 BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.

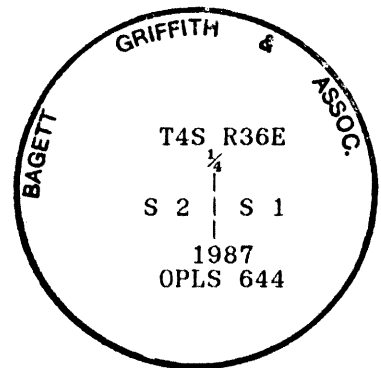
Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with land survey monument sign attached.

Buried the original corner stone Northwesterly and alongside of monument.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on November 12, 1987.
