

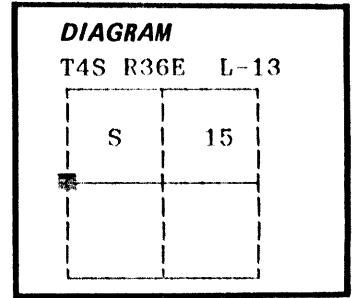
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set a basalt stone 20x14x6 ins 15 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on W face from which;

A pine 14 ins diam bears S40°E 18 lks dist marked 1/4S BT
A pine 20 ins diam bears S45°W 24 lks dist marked 1/4S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument or it's accessories.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 24 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Trees;

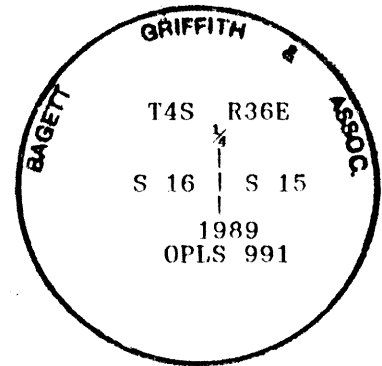
A 10 inch diameter Western Larch bears S55°E, 33.47 feet marked 1/4 S15 BT
A 13 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S85°W, 75.45 feet marked 1/4 S16 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 28, 1989.
