
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 29 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Trees; A 15 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N56°E, 29.04 feet marked C¼ S15 BT A 29 inch diameter Ponderosa Fine bears S70°W, 94.07 feet marked C¼ S15 BT.

Painted a G inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 28, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° magnetic declination. The distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
