CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


History of original corner establishment:

Record of the original survey by Herman A. Gradon, Contract No. 452, dated 1882 states:

Set a basalt stone, 18x10x6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on N face, from which:

a Fir, 10 ins. diam. bears North 15 lks. dist., marked 1/4S BT

a Fir, 8 ins. diam. bears S40°W 23 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S BT



Description of corner evidence found:

Found: A stone, 10"x6" exposed 6", leaning westerly, with plainly visible " $\frac{1}{4}$ " chiseled on North face, (stone found to measure 18"x10"x6" when later removed)

From which: The remains of the original bearing trees:

A 10" Douglas Fir stump, 3 ft tall, rotten, with scribing "BT" visible on an unhealed blaze bears North 9.9 ft. from the base of the corner stone,

A 10" Douglas Fir stump, 1 ft. high, partially rotten, (the tree portion is located approx. 5 ft. East of the stump, with well-healed double blaze visible) bears

\$4.00 M 15.2 ft. from the base of the corner stone S40°W 15.2 ft., from the base of the corner stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the base of the corner stone, we set a 2 "x30" Iron Pipe, 20 ins. in the ground with the original corner stone buried upside down along the West side of this pipe, with brass cap attached marked: T4S R36E

From which we mark new BT's

S 18 S19 PLS 1099 1980

An 8" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S19 BT" on a double blaze bears 560° W 14.3 ft., A 10" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S18 BT" on a double blaze bears N26⁰W 32.8 ft.

Attached brass washer, stamped "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BT's. Placed steel fencepost w/sign 54.4 attached 5 ft. West of corner.

Attached signs and painted BT's per Standard Specifications For Cadastral Survey,

U.S.F.S. Region 6, Oct. 1979 Compass Decl. 20 E.
