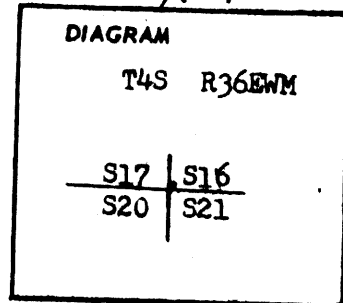
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original survey was by contract No. 452 dated June 16, 1882.
 The original notes state; Set a basalt stone 14x8x6 ins. 9 ins in ground for corner to S 16,17,20 & 21 from which;
 A fir 30" in diam bears N8°E 20 lks dist marked T4S, R36E S 16 BT.
 A fir 22" in diam bears S35°E 62 lks dist marked T4S R36E S21 BT.
 A fir 14" in diam bears S40°W 48 lks dist marked T4S T36E S20 BT.
 A fir 24" in diam bears N8°W 13 lks dist marked T4S R36E S17 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

We could not find any evidence of corner other than bearing trees. Trees in Section 16 and 17 are standing with blaze scar. Tree in section 21 is a fallen log with scribe open for positive identification. Section 20 has a bearing tree standing with blaze scar.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long with a bronze cap on top and a 8" plate welded to bottom. We set the pipe in a hole 22" deep and back filled with stone and tamped soil. A stone monument was raised around pipe.

I stamped the disk.

From the corner the original bearing trees are;
 A fir 28" in diam bears N8°W 13 lks dist.
 A fir 36" in diam bears N8°E 20 lks dist.
 A down fir bears S35°E Approx 62 lks dist.
 A fir 16" in diam bears S50°W 40 lks dist.
 I also established a new bearing tree; A pine 26" in diam bears S74°E 60 ft. distance to center of the tree marked with scribe T4S R36E S21 BT. I placed a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 and National Forest Boundary sign indicating National forest land to south. USFS bearing tree signs were place on each of the bearing trees facing the corner.

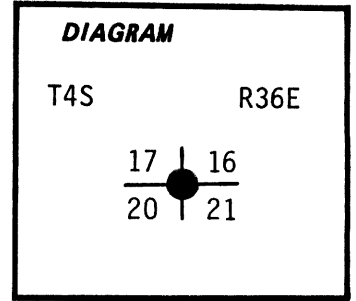

Description of corner evidence found: Found: 2" Iron Pipe, firmly set extending 12" above ground, with brass cap attached, marked:

From which the original Government Survey BTs (Gradon, 1882):

An orig. 30" Fir, now a 46" Douglas Fir, alive, and well healed, bears N8°E 13.2 ft.

An orig. 22" Fir, now down and rotted approx. 24" diam. with scribing "BT" visible on a rotten face, the root hole of which bears approx. S23°E 36.5 ft.

An orig. 14" Fir, now a 24" diam. Fir, alive, and well healed, bears S36°W 31.7 ft. And an orig. 24" Fir, now a 30" Douglas Fir, alive and well healed bears N8°W 8.6 ft.

A Bearing Tree established by Voelz, 1969. A 26" now 28" Ponderosa Pine, with scribing "4S R36E S21 BT" visible on an unhealed double blaze bears S74°E 58.8 ft. (Rec. S74°E 60 ft.)
