

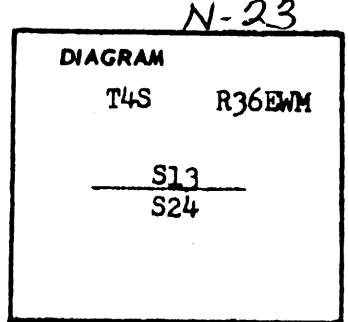

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

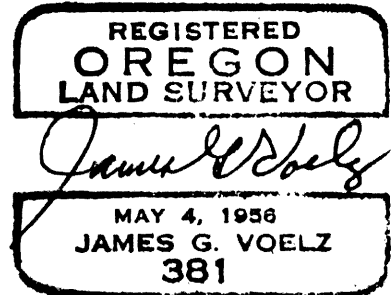
History of original corner establishment:

Original survey by General Land Office (contract survey 1882)
The original notes state; Set a basalt stone 12x10x5 ins.
from which; A pine 22" in diam bears N30°W 53 lks dist
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT.;
A pine 15" in diam bears S15°W 39 lks dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT;



Description of corner evidence found:

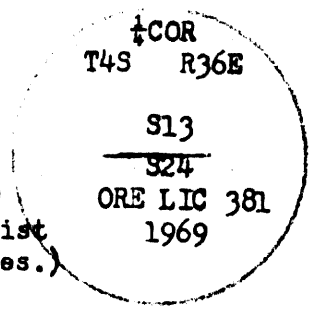
Found stone marked $\frac{1}{4}$
Found - A pine at N30W (now a stump with BT scribe;
Found - A pine snag bears S15°W 39 lks with $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT scribe.;



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long and with a 8" plate welded to bottom. The pipe set to a depth of 19" and back filled with stone and soil and raised a stone monument. I placed the marked stone on top of monument. A bronze cap was placed on top of pipe.

I stamped the disk



At the position of the corner the original bearing trees are;
Original trees are unsatisfactory condition; I set the following new bearing trees; A fir 12" in diam bears N37°W 25.9 ft. dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT; A pine 30" in diam bears S70°W 54.5 ft. dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT. (Distances measured to BT scribe of respective trees.) I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 544 attached. I placed a USFS National Forest Boundary sign on the post indicating National Forest land to South. I placed USFS bearing tree sign on both old and new bearing trees shoulder high facing the corner.
